


# THE PRECIOUS BLOOD OF JESUS

THE PRECIOUS BLOOD OF OUR LORD JESUS, as most of us already know, is the price of our salvation. The following Devotional Prayers to His Precious Blood were offered daily based on the Epistle of St. Paul to the Hebrews.

*(Hebrews 9:11-15)<sup>i</sup>*

[11] But Christ, being come a high priest of the good things to come, by a greater and more perfect tabernacle not made with hand, that is, not of this creation:


[12] Neither by the blood of goats, or of calves, but by His own blood, entered once into the holies, having obtained eternal redemption.

[12] "Eternal redemption": By that one sacrifice of his blood, once offered on the cross, Christ our Lord paid and exhibited, once for all, the general price and ransom of all mankind: which no other priest could do.

[13] For if the blood of goats and of oxen, and the ashes of a heifer being sprinkled, sanctify such as are defiled, to the cleansing of the flesh:

[14] How much more shall the blood of Christ, who by the Holy Ghost offered Himself unspotted unto God, cleanse our conscience from dead works, to serve the living God?

[15] And therefore He is the mediator of the new testament: that by means of His death, for the redemption of those transgressions, which were under the former testament, they that are called may receive the promise of eternal inheritance.



WITHOUT DOUBT, any devotion to the Precious Blood of Our Lord is efficacious for the conversion and salvation of anyone for whom the prayers are offered. In coming to the realization that eternity is but a step or breath away, doing salvific work for God is the only way that we could imitate Jesus in His own redemptive work. When one saves another sinner, St. James said this in his Epistle: "He must know that he who causeth a sinner to be converted from the error of his way, shall save his soul from death, and shall cover a multitude of sins." (James 5:20) Let us invite everyone to do this noble work for the profit, joy and pleasure of Our Loving God Who deserves a lot of recompense for His infinite mercy, love and generosity to sinners like us.

OF THE PRECIOUS BLOOD OF OUR LORD, to St. Mary Magdalene de Pazzi said this:<sup>ii</sup>

1. "It is not as severed from Jesus" Sacred Body that the Precious Blood is now to be adored and offered, but as it is, at this moment, within the living Jesus, in Heaven and in the Blessed Sacrament.

## DEVOTIONAL PRAYERS TO THE PRECIOUS BLOOD OF OUR LORD JESUS CHRIST

### 1. Offering Of The Precious Blood, to Free 1,000 Souls from Purgatory

**Eternal Father**, we offer thee the Precious Blood of Thy Divine Son, Jesus, in union with all the masses said throughout the world today: for all the holy souls in purgatory, for sinners everywhere, for sinners in the universal church, those in our own homes and within our families. Amen.

### 2. A Prayer for The Dying and Who Will Die Within The Next 24 Hours

† **Most Merciful Jesus**, Lover of souls, we beseech Thee, by the agony of Thy Most Sacred Heart, and by the sorrows of Thy Immaculate Mother, wash clean in Thy Precious Blood the sinners of the world who are in their final agony and are to die this day: particularly anyone who would die from among those for whom Thou willest we should pray for and knowest we ought to pray for; from amongst Thy true and faithful Traditional Catholic children throughout the world; and from among those for whom we pray for daily. Grant them Thy mercy, the grace of final atonement for their sins, Thy forgiveness and eternal salvation. Amen. **HEART OF JESUS**, once in agony, *Have mercy on the dying and those who will die today. Amen.*

† **Divine Eternal Father**, Omnipotent and Merciful Creator, Who has so much love and mercy for all miserable sinners that hast deigned to endure the excruciating agony, suffering, crucifixion and death of Thy Dearly Beloved and Only Begotten Son, Our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ for the salvation of these selfsame sinners, please accept this humble offering of all the masses which are being said throughout the world for sinners who will die in the next 24 hours. Lord, remember the good deeds they have done in their lifetimes and the profit Thou didst derive from such deeds. Have mercy on those who would die a sudden death; those in their final agony; those who would die – from among those for whom Thou willest we should pray for and knowest we ought to pray for; from amongst Thy true and faithful Traditional Catholic children throughout the world; and from among those for whom we pray for daily. May the Precious Blood of Jesus, our Redeemer, obtain Thy mercy for the forgiveness of all their sins that they may gain Thy eternal salvation. Amen.

**ETERNAL FATHER**, we offer Thee the Holy Wounds of Thy Dearly Beloved and Only Begotten Son, Our Lord and Saviour, Jesus Christ, and His Precious Blood, for the conversion of sinners and for the relief of the poor souls in Purgatory. Through the same Christ, Our Lord. Amen.

**PRECIOUS BLOOD**, Delight of Holy Souls: *Draw Us!*

## 7. Prayer To The Sacred Heart of Jesus

O GENTLE HEART OF JESUS, ever present in the Blessed Sacrament, ever consumed with burning love for the poor captive souls in Purgatory, have mercy on them. Be not severe in Thy judgment but let some drops of Thy Precious Blood fall upon the devouring flames. O Merciful Saviour send Thy Holy Angels to conduct them to Thy kingdom, that glorious place of refreshment, light and peace, where Thou livest and reignest with The Father and The Holy Ghost, One God, for ever and ever. Amen.

## 8. Holy Water Blessing for The Relief of The Poor Souls in Purgatory

Almighty Father, we beseech Thee, through Thy ineffable mercy and love, grant some relief to the poor, holy souls in Purgatory by the blessing with this Holy Water and together with the powerful Unction of the Precious Blood of Jesus, Thy Beloved Son and Our Redeemer, may gain the commutation of their purgatorial sentence. We beg Thee through the same Christ, Our Lord. Amen. [With Holy Water, bless the center of the earth with the sign of the Cross: In the Name of The **†** Father and of The Son and of The Holy Ghost. Amen. (5X)]

## 9. Prayer For Traditional Seminarians

ALMIGHTY EVER-LIVING GOD, bless these young men whom Thou hast called to be the future shepherds of Thy elect. By the Precious Blood of Our Lord Jesus, keep their hearts, minds, bodies and souls pure and secure from the attacks of the infernal enemy of any manner shape and form. Instill in their hearts the gifts of Thy Holy Ghost that they may persevere in their vocations, be intrepid shepherds of Thy faithful and be steadfast defenders and adherents of the tenets and maxims of Thy Son's old Traditional Catholic Church. Through the same Christ, Our Lord. Amen.
