



Shrove Tuesday: FEAST OF THE HOLY FACE OF JESUS

As many have been astonished at thee,

Surely He hath borne our infirmities and carried our sorrows: and we have thought Him as it were a leper, and as one struck by God and afflicted. But He was wounded for our iniquities, He was bruised for our sins: the chastisement of our peace was upon Him, and by His bruises we are healed.

Dignare, Domine, deprecantibus faciem tuam, sub passionis ignominia quondam absconditam, et nunc. in tui


Deign, O Lord, to grant to those who adore Thy Face, once hidden under the ignominy of the Passion and now veiled

PROMISES OF OUR LORD JESUS CHRIST IN FAVOR OF THOSE WHO HONOR HIS HOLY FACE



1. All those who honor My Face in a spirit of reparation will by so doing perform the office of the pious Veronica. According to the care they take in making reparation to My Face, disfigured by blasphemers, so will I take care of their souls which have been disfigured by sin. My Face is the seal of the Divinity, which has the virtue of reproducing in souls the image of God.
2. Those who by words, prayers or writing defend My cause in this Work of Reparation I will defend before My Father, and will give them My Kingdom.
3. By offering My Face to My Eternal Father, nothing will be refused, and the conversion of many sinners will be obtained.
4. By My Holy Face, they will work wonders, appease the anger of God and draw down mercy on sinners.
5. As in a kingdom they can procure all that is desired with a coin stamped with the King's effigy, so in the Kingdom of Heaven they will obtain all they desire with the precious coin of My Holy Face.
6. Those who on earth contemplate the wounds of My Face shall in Heaven behold it radiant with glory.
7. They will receive in their souls a bright and constant irradiation of My Divinity, that by their likeness to My Face they shall shine with particular splendor in Heaven.
8. I will defend them, I will preserve them and I assure them of Final Perseverance.

DEVOTIONAL PRAYERS TO THE HOLY FACE OF JESUS



1. Prayer To Reproduce The Image Of God In Our Souls

WE SALUTE THEE, we adore Thee, and we love Thee, adorable Face of our Beloved Jesus, as the noble stamp of the Divinity! Completely surrendering our souls to Thee, we most humbly beg Thee to stamp this seal upon us all, so that the Image of God may once more be reproduced by its imprint in our souls. Amen.

2. Holy Face Aspiration (Recite Frequently During the Day, 5X, in honor of His Five Sacred Wounds)

ETERNAL FATHER, we offer Thee the Holy Face of Jesus, covered with blood, sweat, dust and spittle; in reparation for the crimes of communists, blasphemers, and for the profaners of Thy † Holy Name, the Holy Name of our Lord Jesus, the Holy Ghost, our Blessed Virgin Mother, and of the Holy Day of Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation. Amen.

3. Offering of The Holy Face To Appear God's Justice and Draw His Mercy Upon Us

ETERNAL FATHER, turn away Thy angry gaze from all guilty people whose faces have become very unsightly in Thy eyes, especially me. Look instead upon the face of Thy Beloved Son, for this is the Face of Him in Whom Thou art well pleased. We now offer Thee His Holy Face, covered with shame and disfigured by bloody bruises, in reparation for the crimes of our age, in order to appease Thy anger, justly provoked against us. Because Thy Divine Son, Our Redeemer, has taken upon His Head all the sins of His people that they might be spared, we now beg of Thee, Eternal Father, to grant us Thy mercy. Amen.

4. Prayer For The Clergy, Religious and Sinners

ETERNAL FATHER, since Thou hast given us for our inheritance the Adorable Face of Thy Dearly Beloved Son, Jesus, we offer Thee His Holy Face and we beg Thee, in exchange for this

coin of infinite value, to forget the ingratitude of souls dedicated to, and consecrated by Thee and to pardon all poor sinners. Amen.

5. Prayer For The Honor and Glory of The Name of The Eternal Father

ETERNAL FATHER, we offer Thee the adorable Face of Thy Dearly Beloved and Only-Begotten Son, Our Lord and Saviour, Jesus Christ, for the honor and greater glory of Thy Name, Abba, Our Father, for the conversion of sinners, particularly all those for whom Thou willest we should pray for and knowest we ought to pray for; all the errant Traditional Catholics throughout the world; Thy chosen salvific leaders and workers in the world, their families and groups; also my beloved spouse, and our children, our Apos and all those for whom we pray for daily, the salvation of the dying and those who will die within the next 24 hours, particularly anyone who will die from among these aforementioned souls. Amen.

† JESUS, Who in Thy cruel Passion didst become “the reproach and most abject of men; the Man of Sorrows,” I worship Thy Divine Face. Amen.

† DIVINE JESUS, through Thy Face and Name, save us. Our hope is in the virtue of Thy Holy Name!

† JESUS, through the merits of Thy Holy Face, have pity on us and on the whole world. Amen.

8. Additional Holy Face Prayers

† O JESUS, Who in Thy bitter Passion became “the most abject of men, a man of sorrows,” we venerate Thy Sacred Face whereon there once shone the beauty of the Godhead, but now it has become for us as if it were the face of a leper! Nevertheless, under those disfigured features we recognize Thy infinite love, and we are consumed with the desire to love Thee and make Thee loved by all men. The tears, which well up abundantly in Thy Sacred Eyes, appear to us as so many precious pearls that we love to gather up, in order to purchase the souls of poor sinners by means of their infinite value. O Jesus, Whose Adorable Face ravishes our hearts, we implore Thee to fix deep within us Thy Divine Image and to set us on fire with Thy love, that we may be found worthy to come to the contemplation of Thy glorious Face in Heaven.
