Morning Prayers¹

1. The Sign of The Cross:

1.1 (With Holy Water)

IN NOMINE † Patris, et Filii, et Spiritus Sancti.
Amen. (5X)

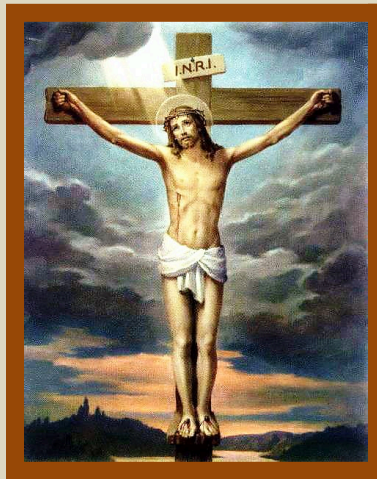
IN THE NAME of The † Father and of The Son and
of The Holy Ghost. Amen. (5X)

(In honor of The Five Sacred Wounds of Our Lord Jesus. This Sign of The Cross is named by Jesus and our Mother as the “Flame of Love” Sign – the Sign that would blind Satan, weaken his wickedness, drive him away from around us and finally from this world. See Appendix B.) Then say the following:

BY THE SIGN OF THE CROSS with this Holy Water and the powerful Unction of Thy Precious Blood, O Lord Jesus Christ, please wash away our sins² and deliver us from all evil of every manner, shape and form always and everywhere, this we beg Thee, through the Immaculate Heart of Mary, Thine and our most loving and caring Mother.

Through the same Divine Unction which Thou freely gives us through Thine infinite, incomprehensible, ineffable love, may Thou find us worthy of standing in Thy Presence and in the Presence of the Eternal Father and the Holy Ghost when our earthly sojourn is over and in our particular judgment, may Thou also find us worthy to be keepers in Thy kingdom: even being the lowest keepers in the lowest level of Thy kingdom would be good enough for us. This we beg of Thee, O Lord Jesus Christ through the same Immaculate Heart of Mary. Amen.

1.2 The I.N.R.I. Prayer³



The Lord of Pardon begs His Eternal Father, “Father, forgive them for they know not what they do.”

With Holy Water on the index finger inscribe the letters ‘I.N.R.I.’ (the same letters engraved on Jesus’ Cross on Calvary) on the forehead and say: **IESUS NAZARENUS, REX IUDERUM – JESUS of NAZARETH, KING of the JEWS, Have mercy on us, save us from hell and protect us from all evil always and everywhere. Amen.**

Jesus promised to St. Edmund of Canada that whosoever says this prayer, ‘The I.N.R.I.’, shall not suffer a sudden and unprovided for death. When fervently recited often, one is always protected from all evil, visible and invisible.]⁴

2.2. St. Magdalena De Pazzi's Purification Prayer⁶

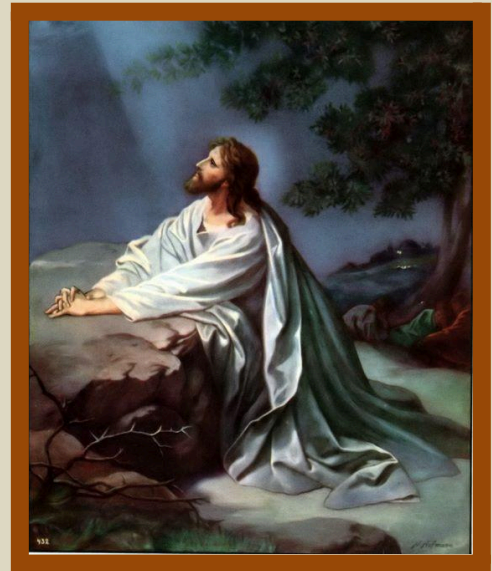
Almighty Father, we place the Precious Blood of Jesus before our lips, before we pray, that all our prayers may be purified before they ascend to Thy divine altar.

Through Christ our Lord.

R. Amen.

Lord Jesus, today, in union with that Divine Intention wherewith Thou didst Thyself praise God, whilst Thou wast on earth, we offer these hours unto Thee.

2.3.2 To Obtain The Spirit and Love of Prayer, The Necessary Virtues and The Science of Salvation

ETERNAL FATHER, we beseech Thee, through Thy ineffable mercy and love, grant us the spirit of prayer and devotion, that we may worthily obey, serve, adore, love, honor, glorify, praise, please and thank Thee with our whole being, always and everywhere. This we beg Thee through Christ Our Lord. Amen.

THROUGH the Immaculate Heart of Mary, I enter into the Holy Will of God and pray – Come Divine Will, to pray in my praying, in my name, the name of my beloved spouse, our children, all those for whom we pray for daily; in the name of all those for whom Thou wilt we should pray for or knowest we ought to pray for, all Thy true and faithful Traditional Catholic children throughout the world, especially Thy clergy, nuns, religious, seminarians, religious aspirants, oblates, tertiaries; Thy chosen salvific leaders and workers in the world, their families and groups, and in the name of all souls: for the love, honor and greater glory of God, Our Father, and in reparation for all sins and for the salvation of souls. Amen.



3. Veni Sanctu Spiritu

COME HOLY GHOST! Fill the hearts of Thy faithful, and enkindle in them the fire of Thy divine love.

V. Send forth Thy Spirit and they shall be created.

R. And Thou shalt renew the face of the earth.

5.1.3. Our Blessed Virgin Mother's Daily Prayer¹²

[By our Blessed Mother to Blessed Maria of Agreda (From the 'Mystical City of God')]

I prostrate myself in Thy Presence, O God Most High, and give Thee thanks and praise for Thine Immutable Being, for Thine Infinite Perfections, and for having created me out of nothing. I acknowledge myself as Thy creature and the work of Thy Hands. I bless Thee and adore Thee. I give Thee honour, magnificence and divinity as the Supreme Lord and Creator of myself and all that exists.

I raise up my soul to place it in Thy Hands. I offer myself with profound humility and resignation to Thee and I ask Thee to dispose of me according to Thy Holy Will during this day and during all the days of my life; and I ask Thee to teach me to fulfill whatever would be for

Thy greater pleasure. I consult Thee, I ask Thy advice, I ask Thy permission, and I ask Thy blessing in everything that I do, think and say today. Amen. *Glory be...*

ACT of FAITH

O, OUR GOD we firmly believe that Thou art One God in Three Divine Persons, The † Father, The Son and The Holy Ghost. We believe that Thy Divine Son became Man and died for our sins, and that He shall come to judge the living and the dead. *(We believe in The Holy Ghost, the Roman Catholic Church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body and life everlasting.)* We believe these and all the truths the Catholic Church teaches, because Thou hast revealed them, Who canst neither deceive nor be deceived. Amen.

ACT of HOPE

O, OUR GOD relying on Thy infinite goodness and promises, we hope to obtain pardon of our sins, the help of Thy grace and life everlasting; through the merits of Jesus Christ, Our Lord, Saviour and Redeemer. Amen.

ACT of CHARITY

O, OUR GOD, we love Thee above all things with our hearts and souls, for Thou art All-Good and deserving of all our love. We love our neighbors as we love ourselves for the love of Thee. We forgive those who have injured us, and we ask pardon for all those whom we have injured. O Lord, forgive us whenever we fail to do so. Amen.

Thank God for this new day and offer yourself to Him.

O OUR GOD, prostrate in Thy presence, we adore Thy boundless majesty, we love Thine infinite goodness above all things, and we thank Thee with our whole being for all the blessings and favors Thou hast bestowed upon us: for Thou hast created us after Thine own image and likeness; for Thou hast redeemed us by the Precious Blood of Thy Dearly Beloved Son, Our Lord and Saviour, Jesus Christ; for Thou hast made us members of Thy true and faithful Traditional Roman Catholic Church; for Thou hast generously given us the spirit and love of continual prayer and devotion, and taught us how to pray well; for Thou hast preserved us during the past night from the infernal enemy, his cohorts, his wickedness and snares, and brought us safely to the beginning of another day – a new day of another opportunity to serve, adore, love, honor, glorify, praise, please and thank Thee, today, always and everywhere.

We consecrate to Thee, in union with the merits of our Lord Jesus Christ: all our thoughts, words, works and all the sufferings of this day. We intend that every thought, word, work and suffering shall be for Thy greater glory; in honor of Thy beloved Handmaid, the Blessed Virgin Mary, our Mother, our Queen, Protectress, Mediatrix and Friend; in reparation for all the offenses against her Most Immaculate Heart and, with Thine permission, for the relief of the neglected poor holy souls in Purgatory. Bless us, that all our words so proceed, our thoughts and actions be directed as to be just, right, profitable, acceptable and pleasing in Thy sight.

O Our God, for the love of Jesus Christ, preserve and protect us, today and always, by Thy mighty power from all sin that we may not fall into it; nor harm, nor danger, nor evil, nor all cyberspace malefactors, nor infernal enemies of our salvation and temporal well-being, nor the infernal covid cartel, the unjust, politicized federal judges and Democratic Party hate and hell-raisers; the Antichrist and Lucifer may come, ruin our lives, endanger our eternal salvation, infiltrate and destroy our I.T. devices and even try to possess our being. *Direct my steps according to Thy word: and let no iniquity have dominion over me.* (Ps. 118:133) *Also over my spouse, our children, all those for whom we pray for daily, our lives and I.T. devices. Lord, protect and keep us safe from the covid poison vaccine, its vaccinators and their ilk.*

O Lord Jesus, by Thy merits, grant that we may live always united to Thee. O Blessed Virgin Mary, our Mother, bless us and protect us under thy virginal mantle. All our holy guardian angels led by St. Michael, and all our heavenly patrons led by St. Joseph, intercede for us. Amen.¹⁴

Resolve to avoid sin and to practice virtue.

We will redouble our efforts so that we may not fall this day into any of those sins which we have heretofore committed in the past: *(here mention them or the following:)* especially my lack of humility, patience, charity and my deficit recompense to Thee, The Eternal Father, the Holy Ghost and our Blessed Mother, for all that Thou and all that Heaven has done for us. Forgive us for all the troubles that we have inflicted and heaped upon Thee, the Eternal Father and the Holy Ghost, which brings so much sorrow to our Blessed Mother, all these we sincerely desire to forsake *(Say the Confiteor)*.

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5.6.2. Prayer to The Father of All Mankind (By Mother Eugenia Elisabetta Ravasio)

HISTORY OF THIS DEVOTION

ON JULY 1, 1932, THE FEAST OF THE PRECIOUS BLOOD OF JESUS, The Eternal Father appeared to Mother Eugenia Ravasio (1907-1990) in Bergamo, Italy. This apparition was approved by His Excellency, Alexandre Caillot, Bishop of Grenoble, in 1946, after a decade of investigation.

MOTHER EUGENIA ELISABETTA RAVASIO was born in San Gervasio d'Adda (now Capriato San Gervasio), a small town in the province of Bergamo, Italy, on 4 September 1907, in a family of peasant background, she received only an elementary education. After a few years working in a factory, she entered the Congregation of Our Lady of the Apostles at the age of 20 years. It was here that her great charismatic personality developed, leading to her election as Mother General of the Congregation at the age of only 25. Quite apart from her spiritual qualities, her work in the social field alone would suffice to ensure her a place in history. In twelve years of missionary activity she opened over 70 centers - each with infirmary, school and church - in the remotest spots of Africa, Asia and Europe. It was she who discovered the first medicine for the cure of leprosy, extracting it from the seed of a tropical plant. This medicine was later studied and developed further at the Pasteur Institute in Paris. She encouraged the apostolate of Raoul Follereau, who, following in her footsteps and building on the foundations laid by her, is regarded as the apostle of the lepers. During the period 1939-41 she planned and brought to fruition the project for a "Lepers' City" at Azopte (Ivory Coast). This was a vast center, covering an area of 200,000 square meters for the care of leprosy sufferers. It remains even today one of Africa's and the world's leading centers of its kind. In recognition of this achievement, France conferred the highest national honour for social work, on the Congregation of Missionary Sisters of Our Lady of the Apostles, of which Mother Eugenia was Superior General from 1935 to 1947. Her most important legacy to us is the Message of the Father, **'The Father Speaks to His Children'**, the only revelation made personally by God the Father, and recognized as authentic by the Church after ten years of the most rigorous examination. The internet has the text of the full testimony issued by Msgr. Alexandre Caillot, Bishop of Grenoble, following the investigation. It is noteworthy that the Eternal Father (in 1932) dictated the Message to Mother Eugenia in Latin, a language totally unknown to her.

Mother Eugenia returned to the Father on 10 August 1990.

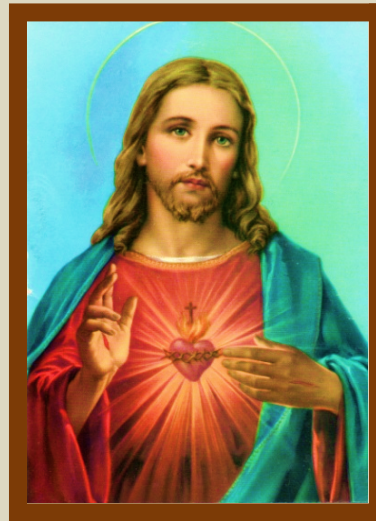
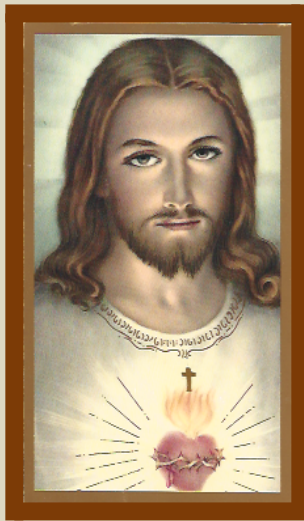

5.6.7.3. Act of Reparation To The Sacred Heart of Jesus

(Published with the Encyclical, *Miserentissimus Redemptor*, May 8, 1928, by His Holiness Pope Pius XI, and ordered to be solemnly recited each year on [The Feast of the Sacred Heart](#). Partial Indulgence 5 years; Plenary under the usual conditions, if recited daily for an entire month. S.Pen Ap., March 18, 1932)

O SWEET JESUS, Whose overflowing charity for men is requited by so much forgetfulness, negligence and contempt, behold us prostrate before Thy altar eager to repair by a special act of homage the cruel indifference and injuries to which Thy loving Heart is everywhere subjected.

Mindful alas! That we ourselves have had a share in such great indignities, which we now deplore from the very depths of our hearts, we humbly ask Thy pardon and declare our readiness to atone by voluntary expiation not only for our own personal offences, but also for the sins of those, who, straying far from the path of salvation, refuse in their obstinate infidelity to follow Thee, their Shepherd and Leader, or, renouncing the vows of their Baptism, have cast off the sweet yoke of Thy law.

We are now resolved to expiate each, and every deplorable outrage committed against Thee; we are determined to make amends for the manifold offences against Christian modesty in unbecoming dress and behavior, for all the foul seductions laid to ensnare the feet of the innocent, for the frequent violation of Sundays and Holy Days, and the shocking

blasphemies uttered against Thee, our Eternal Father, the Holy Ghost, to Thine and our most Blessed Virgin Mother and Thy saints. We wish also to make amends for the insults to which Thy Vicar on earth and Thy priests are subjected, for the profanation, by conscious neglect or terrible acts of sacrilege, of the very sacrament of Thy Divine Love; and lastly for the public crimes of nations who resist the rights and teaching authority of the true Church which Thou hast founded.

Would, O Divine Jesus, we were able to wash away such abominations with our blood. We now offer, in reparation for these violations of Thy divine Honor, the satisfaction Thou didst once make to Thy Eternal Father on the cross and which Thou dost continue to renew daily on our altars; we offer it in union with the acts of atonement of Thy Virgin Mother and all the saints and of the pious faithful on earth; and we sincerely promise to make recompense, as far as we can, with the help of Thy grace, for all the neglect of Thy great love and for the sins we and others have committed in the past. Henceforth we will live **a life of unwavering faith, of purity of conduct, of perfect observance of the precepts of the Gospel and especially that of charity.** We promise to the best of our power to prevent others from offending Thee and to bring as many as possible to follow Thee.

O loving Jesus, through the intercession of the Blessed Virgin Mary, our mother and model in reparation, deign to receive the voluntary offering we make of this act of expiation; and by the crowning gift of perseverance keep us faithful unto death in our duty and the allegiance we owe to Thee, so that we may all one day come to that happy home, where Thou with the Father and the Holy Ghost livest and reignest, One God, world without end. Amen. *Gloria...*

5.6.7.4. Consecration of The Human Race To The Sacred Heart of Jesus (Issued on October 17, 1925, by His Holiness Pope Pius XI, for the annual consecration of the human race to the Sacred Heart on the **Feast of Our Lord Jesus, King**, the last Sunday of October, 5 years Indulgence; Plenary once a month, if recited daily under the usual conditions. On the Feast of Christ the King, same indulgences, under the same conditions, for all who take part in this Act of Dedication. – Pius XI, July 16, 1926; Feb. 15, 1927)

MOST SWEET JESUS, Redeemer of the human race, look down upon us, humbly prostrate before Thy altar. We are Thine and Thine we wish to be; but to be more surely united with Thee, behold each one of us freely consecrate himself today to Thy Most Sacred Heart.

Many indeed have never known Thee; many, too, despising Thy precepts, have rejected Thee. Have mercy on them all, most Merciful Jesus, and draw them to Thy Sacred Heart. Be Thou King, O Lord, not only of the faithful who have never forsaken Thee, but also of the prodigal children who have abandoned Thee; grant that they may quickly return to their Father's house lest they die of wretchedness and hunger.

Be Thou King of those who are still involved in the darkness of idolatry and Islamism, and refuse not to draw them all into the light and kingdom of God. Turn Thine eyes of mercy toward the children of that race, once Thy chosen people. Of old they called down upon themselves Thy blood; may It now descend upon them a laver of redemption and of life.

Grant, O Lord, to Thy Church, assurance of freedom and immunity from harm; give peace and order to all nations, and make the earth resound from pole to pole with one cry: *Praise to the Divine Heart that wrought our salvation; to It be glory and honor forever. Amen. Gloria...*

5.6.7.5. Consecration To The Sacred Heart of Jesus by St. Margaret Mary Alacoque

I GIVE myself and consecrate to the Sacred Heart of our Lord Jesus Christ, my person and my life, my actions, pains and sufferings; so that I may be unwilling to make use of any part

of my being other than to honor, love and glorify the Sacred Heart. This is my unchanging purpose, namely, to be all His, and to do all things for the love of Him, at the same time renouncing with all my heart whatever is displeasing to Him. I therefore take Thee, O Sacred Heart, to be the only object of my love, the guardian of my life, my assurance of salvation, the remedy of my weakness and inconstancy, the atonement for all the faults of my life and sure refuge at the hour of death.

BE THEN, O Heart of goodness, my justification before God the Father, and turn away from me the strokes of His righteous anger.

O HEART of Love, I put all my confidence in Thee, for I fear everything from my weakness and frailty, but I hope for all things from Thy goodness and bounty.

REMOVE from me all that can displease Thee or resist Thy holy will; let Thy pure love imprint Thy image so deeply upon my heart, that I shall never be able to forget Thee or to be separated from Thee.

MAY I obtain from all Thy loving kindness the grace of having my name written in Thy Heart, for in Thee I desire to place all my happiness and glory; living and dying in bondage to Thee. Amen. *Gloria...*

5.6.7.6. Litany of The Sacred Heart of Jesus F

In 1899 Pope Leo XIII approved this Litany of the Sacred Heart of Jesus for public use. This litany is actually a synthesis of several other litanies dating back to the 17th century. Father Croiset composed a litany in 1691 from which 17 invocations were used by Venerable Anne Madeleine Remuzat when she composed her litany in 1718 at Marseilles. She joined an additional 10 invocations to those of Father Croiset, for a total of 27 invocations. Six more invocations written by Sister Madeleine Joly of Dijon in 1686 were added by the Sacred Congregation for Rites when it was approved for public use in 1899. This makes a total of 33 invocations, one for each year of life of our Lord Jesus Christ. A partial indulgence is attached to this litany.⁶⁷

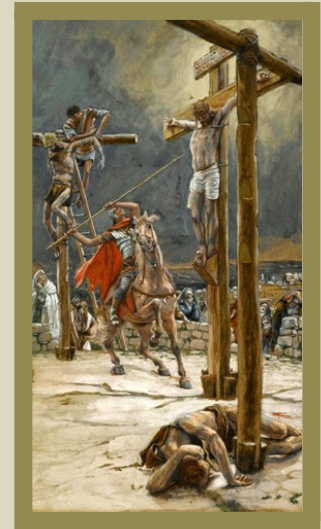

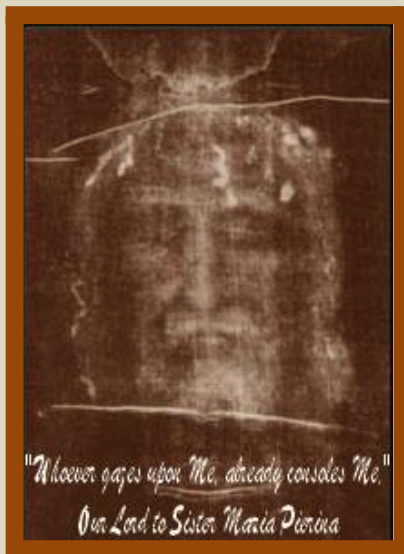

THIS LITANY of the Holy Face of Jesus, printed below, along with the [Golden Arrow Prayer](#), para. 7.4. of this prayer book, is an important part of Devotion to our Lord in His Holy Face. It has been attributed to Sister Mary of St. Peter, a Carmelite Nun, to whom Jesus revealed his ardent desire for this Devotion in reparation for **blasphemies** against God and the **profanation** of Sunday and Holy Days of Obligation. (This offense involves people **engaging unnecessarily in commerce and other such labors and chores on Sunday**, a day meant for rest and reflection on God; and Holy Days of Obligation meant to honor persons and events associated to the Divine Salvific plan for mankind.)

Jesus once told Sister Mary in one of His many revelations to her "Oh, if you only knew what great merit you acquire by saying even once : 'Admirable is the name of God' in a spirit of reparation for blasphemy!" This short prayer of reparation probably gladdens Our Lord's heart indeed! Sister Mary showed great love in honoring Jesus' requests to further the adoption of the Holy Face devotion. One of her associates, Ven. Leo Dupont himself played a key role in spreading this devotion after Sister's death in 1848. Our Lord Himself spoke of His Holy Face and the need for reparation, as mentioned above, a number of times in the 1840's, and indeed, dictated the Golden Arrow prayer to her in 1843!

This Litany below is inspiring in the way Sister Mary lovingly takes us through Jesus' life in this prayer, with special detail as to how His Face appeared during His Passion.

These final lines bring to mind one of our Lord's Promises to Sister Mary in favor of those who would honor Him in this devotion ([Appendix E](#)): *"Those who on earth contemplate the wounds of My Face shall in Heaven behold it radiant with glory."*

O JESUS, Whose Adorable Face is the masterpiece of the Holy Spirit in which the Father is well pleased, *Have mercy on us.*
