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THE FEAST THAT WAS REQUESTED BUT NEVER GRANTED!?

GOD IS OUR FATHER



Abba, Our Eternal Father

"Clouds and darkness are round about Him: justice and judgment are the establishment of His throne." (Psalm 96:2)

"O Lord God of hosts, convert us: and shew Thy face, and we shall be saved." (Psalm 79:20)

(As He appeared to Mother Eugenia Elisabetta Ravasio, July 1, 1932)¹

Words of woe of a forlorn Father Who loves all His children, good and bad, young and old. Being a loving and nurturing Father, He continues to provide for all their needs, from the beginning of time to the present. Seldom does He get any word of gratitude or even an acknowledging glance of appreciation. His actual words were written by the prophet Malachi *"The son honoureth the father, and the servant his master: if then I be a Father, where is My honour? and if I be a Master, where is My fear? saith the Lord of hosts. (Malachi 1:6)*

These words were spoken 400 years before the public life of Our Lord Jesus Christ. These 400 years were named as the "Years of Silence". It is thus called because after the Book of Malachi, God remained silent. He did not speak again through anyone. No prophecies nor any book written. It is therefore very intriguing to be able to read these words, **"If I am a Father, where is My honor?"** In addition to this Malachi verse, God as the "Father" was mentioned only **four (4) times in the Old Testament:**

- Deuteronomy 32:6
- Isaiah 63:16
- Isaiah 64:8
- Jeremiah 31:9

The time lapse between these aforementioned verses were in the hundred of years so much

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so that though they were written and preserved, the Hebrews still did not treat God as a Father but more of a strict disciplinarian 'quick to the whip' as remembered. God as The Father of mankind, **was not repeated enough** to reshape the collective thought that God was **more feared than revered** as a chastising God. So God as The Father of Mankind did not enter into the hearts and minds of the people until Jesus mentioned this in His public teachings.

The first time Jesus referred to God as His Father is found in the New Testament, **at the sermon on the mount** when He taught His disciples **how to pray**; saying, "**Our Father, Who art in heaven...**" (Matthew 6:9). This was a significant shift from the traditional Jewish understanding of God and **revolutionary** for that time, as it emphasized a **personal and intimate relationship with God** that was **not commonly expressed in Jewish tradition**. Jesus used the term "Father" to illustrate **the intimate affection which God has for all mankind** even from the beginning of time.

To inculcate to His followers and to all those who listened to His preaching the affection the Eternal Father has for man, **Jesus mentioned God as His and our Father seventy five (75) more times** after the mount sermon. The following are the verses of the New Testament where Jesus mentioned God as His and our Father (<https://www.answers.com>):

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These repetition teachings did finally turn the impression of the listeners of their God from a judgmental, penalizing Deity to a loving, nurturing, caring, beneficent Father.

The first apostle to fully realize the affectionate nature of The Eternal Father was John, one of the sons of Zebedee. Having been the son of a good, loving, teaching, nurturing and protective father, Zebedee, John realizes that everything that the Father has done for mankind was due to His loving nature. From creation to their present time, John realized that God is love more than justice enforcer. His belief was fully reinforced by the excruciating Passion and death of Jesus on the cross. The idea of a Father sending His Only Son to a foreign land to be tortured and killed for the redemption of the self-same killers is beyond comprehension to any individual. Mulling this divine plan of salvation made John realize that God the Father is so full of love and paternal responsibility for the salvation of mankind that He, God the Father loves mankind more. So in his gospel he wanted mankind to know how this love is beyond any man's comprehension. He wrote, *"For God so loved the world, as to give His only begotten Son; that whosoever believeth in Him, may not perish, but may have life everlasting."* (John 3:16)

THE APPARITION OF GOD THE FATHER

This month, August, the eighth month of the year should have been a significant one for all of Christendom. For God the Father appeared on July 1, 1932, the Feast of The Precious Blood of Jesus, to Mother Eugenia Ravasio (1907-1990) in Bergamo, Italy. This apparition was approved by His Excellency, Alexandre Caillot, Bishop of Grenoble, in 1946, after a decade of investigation. The Eternal Father appeared as a Young Man, as shown on page 1.

Ed's Note: Our Father's first words to Mother Ravasio: "I have already told you and now I say it again: I cannot give My beloved Son another time to prove My love for men! I am now coming among them in order to love them and to make them know this love, assuming their image, their poverty. Look, now I am putting aside My crown and all My glory to take on the appearance of an ordinary man!"

It would be easier to obey our superiors when we see them. No one has worked for the 'invisible boss'. One way or another, one sees his boss whether in pictures or company conferences and functions. They perform well or badly on how they feel about their boss, whose image is always in their minds.

Even in worship, man has to come up with something concrete in order to worship. Pagans make statues made of stone, wood or another in order to pay homage to whom they want to pay homage. Catholics, in using portraits or icons of Jesus and our Blessed Mother are more attentive to their prayers knowing the likeness of whom they are paying homage to. Remember how the Hebrews (the Israelites) wanted to have their own king rather than just obeying the unseen God through his prophets? This is human nature, man has to see to believe. So the Israelites got what they wished for and chastisements came upon them for their 'to see is to believe' failed desire.

Has anybody seen God? We have seen Jesus, through various portraits done through the centuries. But not Our Eternal Father, until He decided to show Himself to mankind on July 1, 1932, The Feast of the Precious Blood of Our Lord Jesus.

Seeing the amazed look of Mother Ravasio, He said, "Man gets old. I do not, because I am eternal." He looks like Jesus. This look-alike similarity with the Eternal Father was confirmed by Our Lord Jesus to St. Philip when St. Philip said "Lord, shew us the Father, and it is enough for us." (John 14:8). Our Lord Jesus' response was, "Have I been so long a time with you; and have you not known Me? Philip, he that seeth Me seeth the Father also. How sayest thou, shew us the Father?" [John 14:9]

Now that we know how our Eternal Father looks it is easier to say the Lord's Prayer (the Our Father). How come it took God this long to show Himself to mankind? His foreknowledge is beyond comprehension and

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understanding. He always does the right thing at the right time. So let us just be thankful that He came in 1932 to let us see Him like us, mortal man.

There are so-called experts who critique this devotion and apparition of our Eternal Father stating that **"He is spirit and cannot be seen according to the Scriptures!"** These intellectuals must have missed the statement of God the Father in the Green book, "The Father Speaks to His Children". Our Father said, **"Look, now I am putting aside My crown and all My glory to take on the appearance of an ordinary man!"** Is this statement hard to understand? He is God and Spirit, Who could do anything. He shows Himself as an ordinary man because mankind needs to see Who He is that we call our Father!

A Traditional priest who later became close to the Novus Ordo Vatican seaters, once told me that he has accepted the apparition of 1932 as authentic but told me this, **"Do not push the picture of Our Eternal Father as a Young Man because we all know from time immemorial that He is an Old Man."**

What an insult to the Eternal Father! He shows Himself as a Young Man to make people be more comfortable with praying to Him and calling Him Father but the intellectuals say, **"Spirit, You are! Spirit You should remain! You cannot show Yourself as a human being because we do not want You to mess up the Scriptures!"** Also, **"Old Man You are, Old Man You should be! Do not come here as a Young Man because it messes up our conception of You as Father!"**

No wonder our Eternal Father spoke those words, **"If I am a Father, where is My Honor?"** The intellectuals have boxed Him into what they want people to know and they do not want Him to do otherwise! Sorry, guys. Eternal damnation is something that intellectual pride guarantees for those who are wiser than God! No wonder we have all these troubles. He came as a Young Man, and they told Him, **"We do not want to see You the way You want!"**

WHERE IS MY HONOR?

In that apparition God the father requested that the **first Sunday of August of each year** be dedicated solely to Him as a feast day in the Catholic liturgical calendar. Our Eternal Father said that the Catholic Church had feasts for the Blessed Trinity, Jesus Christ the King, and the Holy Ghost. But **a feast solely dedicated to honor Him, there is none.**

If the apparition is true and the request was in black and white for all to see, how come nothing came about it? What happened? **Nothing happened to this request! There is no Feast for God the Father?**

Apparently the Pope of that time did not even pay attention to this great apparition. The Pope at that time was Pope Pius XI (Ambrogio Damiano Achille Ratti, Italian; 31 May 1857 – 10 February 1939) was head of the Catholic Church from 6 February 1922 until his death in February 1939. He was also the first sovereign of the Vatican City State upon its creation on 11 February 1929. **An efficacious vicar of Christ whose vicariate introduced major reforms to the Vatican. He did many good things for the Catholic Church and fought hard for its Orthodoxy.** He even established the Feast of Christ the King in 1925 through his encyclical "Quas Primas". Maybe, he believed that the Feast of the Blessed Trinity, established by Pope John XXII in 1334, is similar enough to the feast requested by our Eternal Father. But this surmise **is not appropriate** for the First Person of the Blessed Trinity is not the Unity Himself.

We have to tremble when our Eternal Father makes a request and this request was not even considered. This writer shudders at the thought of what Pope Pius XI had to face in his particular judgment when this request was put forth to his attention and his inaction on it. To think that he did not even consider this request from God the Father Himself, seems too unthinkable to digest. We have to pray for his soul, hoping that his good works for God and

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His Church despite his failure to get this Divine request, might have saved him from some chastisement.

Mankind would have been better if our Eternal Father's request was done. Why say so? Because **God's gratitude to those who obey Him and do His will far exceeds anything man could comprehend.** Being God, His gratitude opens the floodgates of His generosity to those who do His will. The ancient fathers and the saints have all been beneficiaries of this floodgate of gratefulness that they do what they preached so that others will benefit from the incomprehensible generosity of God.

THE INCREDIBLE GENEROSITY OF GOD

This poor sinner was himself a beneficiary of our Eternal Father's miraculous generosity. Back on February 29, 1996, I was in a legal dispute with my former employer's insurance company over my disability and we were in dire financial straits.

I had an old station wagon so beat up that it looks like a junkyard salvage work. I was on the way to Alameda Naval Station (California) to pick up my wife from work. It was raining hard and then the vent fan stopped working and my front windshield was fogging up. Coming out of the Caldicot tunnel (Oakland, California) my situation was getting worse. I could hardly see anything beyond the car's hood! In desperation, I cried, **"Lord help me! Let me not cause any accident nor hurt other people!"** Suddenly, the vent fan started working again and the visibility was normal again. Then I prayed, **"Lord give us a new car. This one is done and gone. I know that when You say it, it will happen. One word from Thee, and we will have a car tomorrow!"** After that I was able to pick up my wife, came home and settled in for the evening.

My daughter and her husband called and said that they might be coming home late because they were going back to a Nissan dealership to listen to the offer of the salesperson who showed them a car during their lunch break. My daughter did not even know what happened to the old car and me earlier in the day. The big factor that might affect her buying a car is the fact that she was just new on the job and had no established credit history. Around 11 PM they arrived with **a brand new 1996 Nissan Sentra, gave us a hundred dollars and an incredible story!**

The story went like this. After all their negotiations, she was able to get the dealership to give her the car at invoice price and with no money down. But then after looking at the fact that she has to get her own car insurance and the possibility of making a considerable expense in 45 days, she backed off the deal and decided to go home.

At the parking lot the sales manager came running towards them and said, **"If you go back to the dealership, I will give you five hundred reasons to take the car home tonight!"** With egging by the manager they returned to the dealership. Inside, the manager pulled **five \$100 bills** from his pocket and said, "I will pay for your car insurance for three months and you will not make any car payments for three months too. Sign on the dotted line, and I will give you these crisp five \$100 bills, take the car home off the lot and have a nice dinner!" Surprised at this offer and still hesitant to sign, they asked. "What is wrong with the car? Is it a lemon?"

The manager said, "It is brand new with less than 14 miles. **I just have to sell one more Nissan Sentra tonight to meet my monthly quota.** This is the last day of the month. You are the only ones left in this lot who could help me do it. Besides, it has been raining all day. At this hour of the night, I do not think anyone would show up to buy a car. If the car proves to be a

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lemon, I will replace it with a new one. I guarantee it. I need your help." With this assurance, they signed the contract and got a brand new car at the dealer's cost, with no money down, no credit history, no car and insurance payments for three months and five hundred dollars in cash! My prayer was answered over and above my petition!

Incredible as it seems this is how God works! The local pastor at that time when blessing the car that Sunday could not believe the above transaction. Do you know of anyone buying a car with those concessions and getting paid to do so? I do not believe this has happened to anyone. Let me know if I am wrong.

I have other experiences with The Eternal Father's generosity that are almost incredible but we will not have time to include them all. Mankind did miss out on some wonderful things that would have come out of our Eternal Father's generosity.

NATURE IN UPHEAVAL

With the denial of our Eternal Father's request in the background, mankind seems to have entered into the era of Satan's reign divulged by Pope Leo XII in 1884 which caused him to compose the Prayer to St. Michael. Liberalism, modernism. Progressivism, paganism, Satanism, gender manipulation, birth control, abortion, divorce, unpunished homicide and theft, and everything evil is now the new standard that mankind is living through under the heavens.

Nature in its usual behaviour as God's faithful creation seems to be in upheaval for this sinful revolt against its Creator. The frightening events of the recent days makes us wonder what we have to do to appease God and avoid His justice.

Floods of cataclysmic proportions are happening all over the world. No continent seems to be exempted from destructive flash flooding which has killed thousands and caused billions of dollars in damages. Drought in several continents have caused emigration and actual loss of lives due to famine and diseases caused by lack of potable water. Rain in some places does not fall while in others they come cascading like waterfalls which cause flash floods, death and destruction.

- 12 quakes between magnitude 6 and 7
- 230 quakes between magnitude 5 and 6
- 1,733 quakes between magnitude 4 and 5
- 5,154 quakes between magnitude 3 and 4
- 11,684 quakes between magnitude 2 and 3
- 38,641 quakes below magnitude 2 that people normally don't feel.

This upheaval of nature is not yet the end times for the prophecies of the prophets and the saints and the Book of Revelations have all come down with some specific conditions for the end times, which only God knows. But the present chastisement is nothing more than our Eternal Father's scolding and loving call for our return to Him.


WHAT SHOULD MANKIND DO NOW?

We should make it a daily habit of saying 'The Fiat to God The Father'. Below is the prayer card for 'The Fiat' available from Mary's Call. I recite the "Our Father" after each 'Fiat'.
