

## HATED THAT GUY SO MUCH! THEN CREMATE HIM!

## DIVINE REMEDY FOR THE SUFFERING CREMATED SOULS

God in His infinite mercy always gives us remedies for all chastisements that we have earned by our errors. In this particular situation of accidental or voluntary **cremation of a Purgatory bound soul**, Our Lord Jesus Christ gave St. Teresa the following prayer and conditions to be offered for the release of the suffering souls from the **fire of continuous cremation**.

### The Prayer:

*“Jesus Christ, Lord of life and conqueror of death, You rose in a glorious body showing the final destiny of all sanctified flesh; by the power of Thy Cross, which sanctifies all suffering, heal in the soul of (name of cremated person) the wound caused by the violent separation from its bodily temple. Accept Lord my small suffering as medicine for his/her, and grant him/her access to the purifying fire he/she needs for his/her salvation. Protect the living from the disturbances caused by this suffering and grant us wisdom to help all souls in a similar condition. Amen.”*

### Conditions to be Met for the Efficacy of the Prayer:

1. The one praying for the cremated soul must be in a state of grace i.e. no mortal sin.
2. The prayer must be said in front of The Blessed Sacrament.
3. The prayer must be recited for nine consecutive days at the same time each day.
4. A semi-fasting is required, that is, at least one full meal is abstained from during this novena.

**In Conclusion:** If you love someone who just died, then voice out your love for this person by stopping any intention of cremating his/her remains, if they already planned it. This is true love and concern for a beloved one. To remain silent, means you will also bear the consequences of this cremation as revealed in the writing of St. Teresa. It is going to be very unsettling.
